Policies & Program Description: GROUP PIANO

- Piccolo's unique, research based program combines Orff, Dalcroze, Suzuki, Kodaly, Reggio Emilia, Montessori philosophies into one comprehensive curriculum.
- Age requirement for each class is flexible. The teacher, in consultation with the parent ,will determine the most beneficial class for the child. This will depend on the child's developmental level. A student may be assigned to a younger age group if the child is a complete beginner without any prior experience in music learning, or be accelerated to an older group if the child shows advanced skills.
- Classes includes keyboard playing, solfège, singing, ear training, music theory, creative activities, music with movement, rhythmic practice, note reading, ensemble playing, and more! Classes are fun, playful, and age-appropriate for young children.

Policies during class:

- Class meets once a week for 30-50 minutes (depends on age, student's level, or class size)
- Adult attendance with the student is mandatory. Adult caregivers must be with their child at all times. Teachers are not
 responsible for providing childcare before or after classes. Parents must make their own arrangements for the supervision of
 any other (non-enrolled) children. No additional children or guests will be allowed in the classroom.

- Yelling, loud noises, jumping on furniture, or running is not allowed when class is in session. If the child is having a very difficult time, adult and child may step outside, then return when child is ready to join.
- Food or drinks are not allowed in the studio.

Enrollment policies:

- Classes are offered in September, January, and Summer. Semesters run from Sept-Jan (Fall) or Feb-June (Spring). There are 18 classes each semester (or 36 classes per year, Sept-June). Summer Classes are held in July (separate 1-month enrollment and tuition). Students may enroll mid-semester (tuition prorated), but may be required to take catch-up lessons outside of regular class schedule.
- The student may withdraw anytime, but must enroll for a minimum of 2 months.
- Monthly Tuition must be paid in advance through Brightwheel autopay either with your bank account or credit card. You will be charged on the first of each month. Tuition will be prorated if you enroll mid-month. Students will receive a new book and downloadable mp3. Fees for materials are billed separately: \$30-\$50 depending on student level.
- Withdrawal: A minimum of 30 days advance notice is required before the intended date of withdrawal. Email your request to ThePiccoloMusicStudio@gmail.com. No verbal requests will be honored. Example: if you plan to end music lessons on May 31st, you must email your request to withdraw on or before April 30.
- Refunds: Refund requests must be emailed to ThePiccoloMusicStudio@gmail.com. No verbal requests will be honored. Refunds not guaranteed/may or may not be approved. Material fees are non-refundable/non-returnable as the studio purchase materials in advance.

Attendance policies

- Parents and adult caregivers are responsible for their children's regular attendance. Consistent attendance is encouraged as new concepts and theories are taught and reinforced each session. There are <u>no</u> credits or refunds given for missed classes. Because of the nature of our group program, makeup lessons are not available. However, the teacher will email the home assignment for the week.
- If your student need to miss a class, please call or email 24 hours in advance if you wish to attend remotely via zoom. Remote attendance would be appropriate for students who may be sick. Children and adult caregivers who are sick must stay home.

Release of liability: Parent/guardian assume all risk of injury or harm to the child(ren) or adult(s) participating in musical activities at the music studio. Parent/guardian agree to releases, indemnify, defend and forever discharge Dainellee Stoll and staff from all liability, claims, demands, damages, costs, and expenses in the unlikely event of injury sustained by your child(ren) or adult student during the course or as a result of a musical activity.

Photo/video release: Parent/guardian grant permission to take photographs/videos of the students to use in promotional materials (like website, advertisements, brochures).

Student Progress. Students' progress depends on how diligently and effectively they practice. Parents or guardians are encouraged to consistently support and guide the student's practice at home. Adults are encouraged to take notes during class so they can review activities at home with the child. It is very important for the student to practice regularly at home.
